Joseph A. "Jay" Portman III, 84, of Dunkirk died Saturday morning, August 31, 2019 at the Chautauqua Nursing and Rehab Center in Dunkirk. He was born November 4, 1934 in Bridgeville, PA, son of the late Joseph II and Jean (Burdis) Portman.

At the age of 16, Joe's family moved to Sherman to begin grape farming. Joe began working at Welch's in Westfield, served in the U.S. Navy aboard the USS Boston CAG-1, then nearly a decade in the office at True Temper, retiring from Niagara Mohawk Power Company following almost 25 years.
