

JOHN COURSEY OBITUARY passed away 08/28/2009

John J. Coursey 88, was born in Rosebud, S.D., June 9, 1921, to Lila and Joseph Coursey. His father was a government attorney for the Bureau of Indian Affairs. John had two sisters and one brother. He was a graduate of the University of Oregon and served in the U.S. Navy in World War II aboard the USS Boston. He married Patricia Ildstad in
