

## Patrick Joseph Crawford

Patrick Joseph Crawford died Saturday December 23rd, 2023, at his home in Beaverdale. Pat was born January 11, 1938, the son of Margaret (Conley) Crawford and Harold J. Crawford. He graduated from Dowling Catholic High School in the Class of 1956 and the University of Notre Dame in the class of 1960. He and Mary Figge were married on June 27, 1964, in Washington, DC.

Pat was commissioned as an officer in the Navy in 1960 after serving aboard the USS Boston CAG-1 and other duty stations leaving active duty in 1965 but continuing to serve in the Navy Reserve before retiring as lieutenant commander.
