Retired tile setter, he passed away on Monday May 28th at the Massachusetts General Hospital in Boston after a long battle with overwhelming illness. He was 87

years of age. Born and raised in Chelsea, he was the loving son of the late Frank and Constance Folino. He attended Local schools and was a graduate of Chelsea High School Class of 1942'. As a young man he worked at WT Grants in Chelsea. While working there he met and courted Mabel Mullen.
