



Samuel Sica Obituary

Samuel Angelo Sica, age 80 of Mechanicsburg, passed away Monday, March 27, 2017 at the Harrisburg Hospital surrounded by his family. Samuel was a loving husband, father and grandfather who will be dearly missed. He was born June 16, 1936 in Scranton, PA a son of the late John and Mary (Piedmont) Sica.
