



Joseph D. Sperduti, Sr., 82, of Brick, passed away on Tuesday, July 19, 2022.

Born in Niagara Falls, NY to the late Joseph and Irene Sperduti, he grew up there and lived in Point Pleasant and later Brick for most of his life. Joe was owner and operator of Sleepy Hollow Exxon, Point Pleasant, for over fifty-two years.

He was a United States Navy veteran that served aboard the USS Boston CAG-1 and was a founding member of the Bridge Avenue Business Association, which later became the Point Pleasant Chamber of Commerce.
