Daniel Boles Tagtmeyer, 85, of Cazenovia, WI, died early in the morning of July 15, 2024. Dan was born to Leonard and Alice Tagtmeyer in Fort Wayne, IN, on July 10, 1939. He attended Concordia Lutheran High School in Fort Wayne. After his mother's untimely passing, he was raised on a farm in Allen County Indiana, then joined the Navy as a young man. He met Bernice B. Bailey (deceased) in Milwaukee, WI, and they married on October 18, 1958. During the 1970's he earned a BA in History at Indiana University, Ft. Wayne.

Dan's life was filled with variety; after his stint in the Navy, he was a machinist, a Gandy Dancer on the railroad, a house painter, and had other occupations.
