

TRINITY COUNTY, Texas ([KETK](#)) – Sheriff Woody Wallace released a statement Saturday night saying the remains of the missing Trinity County couple, 60-year-old Karen Waters and 56-year-old Clayton Waters, have been found.

### **Sheriff: Son of missing Trinity County couple and wife charged with murder**

“After a great lengthy investigation, we feel that we have located the remains of who we believe are Karen Waters and Clayton Waters. We have two people in custody in connection with their deaths,” said Wallace.

Wallace issued a missing person alert for the couple on Sept. 20 stating they had been missing for a week. On Sept. 29, Wallace issued an updated statement saying they had been missing for almost two weeks and the investigations had determined their absence was not voluntary.

### **Sheriff: 2 missing East Texans did not leave voluntarily**

According to officials, [two people](#) are currently in custody in connection with their deaths.

### **Sheriff: The remains of missing Trinity County couple have been found**

The couple had been missing for about two weeks before their remains were found on Saturday, officials said.

Karen Water’s son Jacob Patrick Chrones, 34, and his wife Adeline Esmerelda Aparicio-Rodriguez, 35, were both charged with murder and tampering with physical evidence, according to Sheriff Wallace.

Authorities said their bail is set at \$1.5 million for murder and \$50,000 for tampering with physical evidence.

The bodies of the man's mother and her husband were cremated in Jacob Chrones' backyard firepit, the sheriff said
